10	WHEREAS, the Washington County Board's 2017-2019 Strategic Priorities For the
11	Quality of Life of the Citizens of Washington County named Parks Fiscal Sustainability a top
12	priority and included the goal of making the County Parks System independent of the property
13	tax levy, while fostering fiscal responsibility, sustainable services, operational excellence, trust
14	and transparency by ensuring accountability, integrity, efficiency and innovation; and
15	WHERE AC des Country Desired about 1 des 2010-2021 Desire Elevel Country and Elevel
16	WHEREAS, the County Board adopted the 2019-2021 Parks Fiscal Sustainability Plan
17	on August 8, 2018 via 2018 Resolution 34, which includes soliciting proposals for non-metallic
18	mining partners near the former nonmetallic mining site at Heritage Trails County Park; and
19	WHEREAS, the Planning and Parks Department has developed a preliminary concept to
20 21	create an approximate 32 acre lake through nonmetallic mining reclamation; and
22	create an approximate 32 acre take through nonmetanic mining rectamation, and
23	WHEREAS, providing the public with access to waterways and related amenities
24	satisfies the County's goal of offering access to unique amenities and natural resources within
25	the Washington County Park System; and

27	WHEREAS, the history of Heritage Trails as a sand and gravel pit, demand for mining
28	locations and usage data at Heritage Trails County Park make its location ideal for this type of
29	innovative public-private partnership; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, preliminary costs of up to \$15,000 related to this project, as well as the cost
32	of ongoing operations will be paid from the Park Enterprise Fund, and it is not anticipated that
33	any tax levy support will be required;

35	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Washington County Board of
36	Supervisors that the Planning and Parks Department is authorized to further develop and pursue
37	the enactment of the proposed Heritage Trails Lake and Mining Development Project subject to
38	all necessary reviews and approvals which may include a preliminary materials analysis, future
39	budget appropriations, and required zoning approvals.
40	BE IT FURTEHR RESOLVED that the County Board Chair and County Clerk are
41 42	authorized to execute any documents related to the project subject to the review of the County
42	Attorney.
